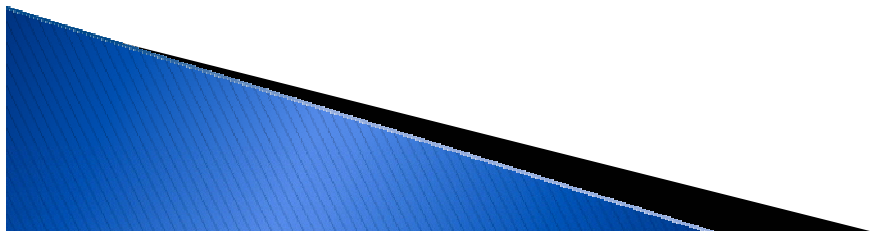

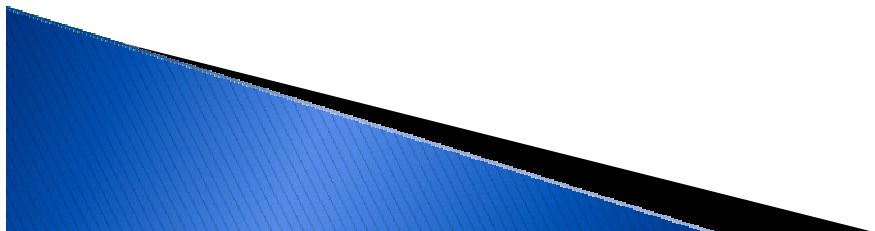
BPC RULES

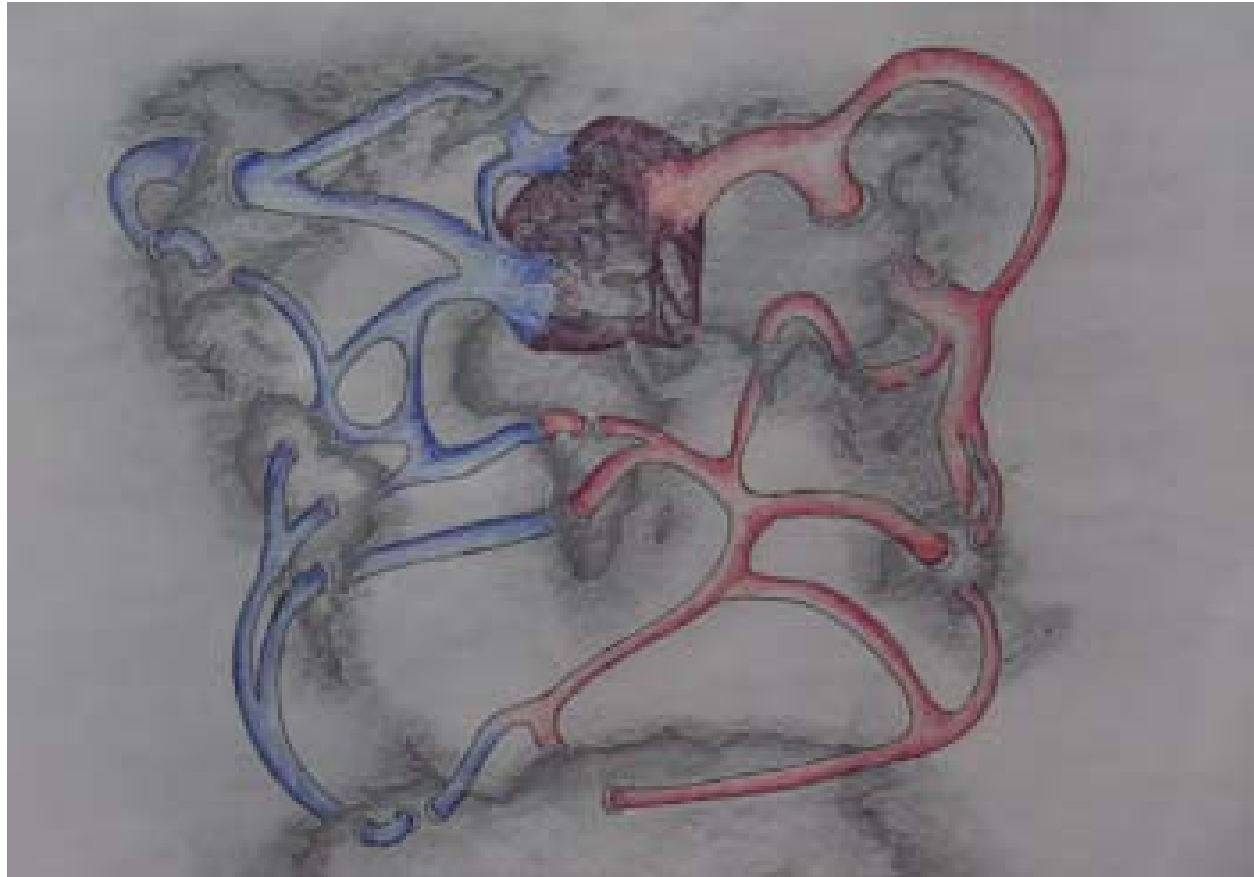
